Rules and Information for Queen Mallard

We would like to invite you to vie for the coveted title of Queen Mallard LXVII at 7:00 pm on Saturday, November 18, 2023. We want this to be a day and evening filled with fun and fellowship. This is a great way to meet new friends and win some really amazing prizes. There are hundreds of dollars in cash and prizes awarded to the winners and their courts, including a \$1500 scholarship to Queen Mallard!

Rules:

Entry fee for Queen Mallard is \$60 for beauty and \$15 for photogenic. Deadline to enter is November 6, 2023. Any entries after this date will include a \$15 late registration penalty and will not be listed in the program book or be pictured in the newspaper.

Queen Mallard contestants will compete in interview, evening wear, and photogenic (optional). There will also be an award given for Miss Congeniality, Crowd Favorite and Overall Interview Award. The newly crowned winner will be required to attend activities scheduled by the Queen Mallard Committee at the Wings Over the Prairie Festival and at events scheduled throughout her reign.

Contestants must be between the ages of 16 and 21 the day of the pageant and must reside in the counties of Arkansas, Lonoke, Monroe, Prairie, Grant and Jefferson.

Rehearsal for the pageant will be held at 8:30 am on November 18, 2023 at the Grand Prairie Center in Stuttgart. **PLEASE BE ON TIME** so that everyone will have enough time to prepare for interviews. If you do not attend rehearsal, you will be disqualified from the competition that night and no refund will be given. Please remember to bring your shoes that you will be wearing that night to rehearsal.

Interviews will begin at 2:00 pm at the Grand Prairie Center. If you are late for your interview, you will not be allowed to make it up. So please be on time!

Contestants selected for the Top 10 will be required to answer an on stage question.
